



CRITERIA FOR SCORING

- ◆ Creative use of mystery props **5 points**
 - able to use the mystery props in an unusual way, making them an integrated part of the presentation
 - incorporation of futuristic ideas using props
- ◆ Creative use of mystery quote **5 points**
 - use saying in the appropriate context
 - show understanding of saying
 - punning in the saying is permissible
- ◆ Creative use of suggested materials **5 points**
 - able to use materials creatively and to their maximum advantage to suit the action plan
 - variety of materials used
 - use of materials to create both props and costumes
- ◆ Communication of ideas **5 points**
 - ideas presented effectively
 - use of both dialogue and non-verbal techniques (gestures, body language, facial expressions) to convey team's ideas
- ◆ Creativity of presentation **5 points**
 - originality of ideas, props and presentation
 - incorporation of futuristic ideas
 - energy put into performance
- ◆ Involvement of participants **5 points**
 - all team members involved throughout
 - even distribution of roles
- ◆ Variety and quality of dramatic styles **5 points**
 - use of different styles such as song, dance, characterization, humour, poetry, etc
 - these styles positively contributing to the presentation
 - positive audience response to styles
- ◆ Relevance to presentation of action plan **5 points**
 - clearly shows what the action plan is and how it will be implemented
- ◆ Quality of dramatic performance **5 points**
 - convincing performances
 - entertaining
 - clarity of speech
 - confidence



- ◆ Overall persuasiveness of presentation **5 points**
 - persuade audience that this is an effective means of achieving their goal
 - 'sells' the idea to the audience
 - interesting

PENALTIES

Points will be deducted as follows
