This workshop is designed for coaches who would like to:

- Introduce or further develop a school's community-based program.
- Have a structured program for project-based work.
- Offer an extension to a school's Academic Enrichment Program.
- Fulfil the research and service aspects of the International Baccalaureate curriculum.

What will I learn?

- The six-step FPS thinking process. This process underpins each of the FPS learning options.
- How to develop a successful Community Problem Solving team
- The reporting elements for a Community Problem Solving project

What are the benefits of the training?

- Participants gain an in-depth understanding of the Community Problem Solving learning option and have the opportunity to practice the six-step model in a supportive environment.
- Participants acquire a framework for teaching and assessing 21st-century skills.
- Course content meets AITSL standards allowing participants to add up to six hours to their professional accreditation requirements.
- Participants meet other new and experienced FPS coaches providing them with an opportunity to develop networks with those on the same learning path.
