What are the benefits of becoming an FPS Evaluator?

- GIPS Evaluator Training ensures individuals can assess student work consistently and constructively, fostering the development of student's critical thinking and analytical skills as they address global challenges.
- For Coaches: This training provides a deeper understanding of the Global Issues Problem Solving program, enhancing coaching skills and improving the ability to guide students through the problem-solving process.
- For Students: Becoming an evaluator sharpens your own Global Issues Problem Solving skills, allowing you to better engage with the program's methodologies.

What's included?

- All resources and materials, including access to the evaluator portal in FPSOnline.
- 6 hours of professional development – The presenter works through the six steps of the Future Problem Solving evaluation procedures using a training booklet.
- Opportunity to qualify to become an active FPS GIPS evaluator. At the conclusion of the workshop, participants submit an evaluation of a booklet for assessment to be accepted as a Qualified National Evaluator.
- Certificate of course completion
